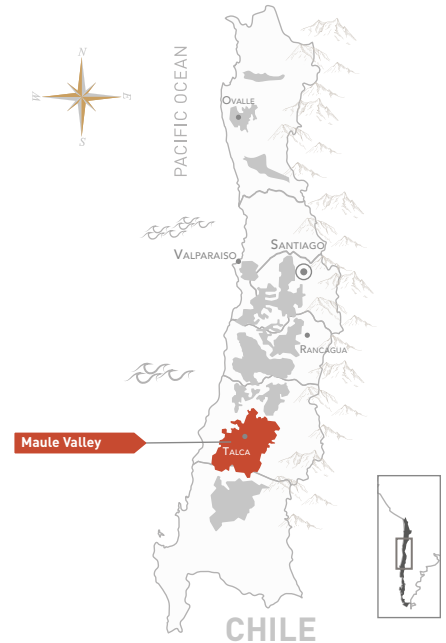

VINEYARD

The País grapes come from the area of Melozal, located in the Secano Interior (Interior Rainfed zone) of the Maule Valley. The region's Geography features the distinctive rolling hills of the Coastal Range and a warm, dry climate. The soils are granitic, with a red clay matrix. The vineyards are over 80 years old, and grow very naturally, high head-pruned and only irrigated by rain. During the growing season, the grapes ripen with barely a few applications of powdered sulfur, and they are harvested at the beginning of April.

VINIFICATION

The grapes were harvested by hand in 400-kilo bins. A part of the fermentation took place with whole berries (60%) and the rest was destemmed and crushed. It is fermented in stainless steel tanks and a fraction in concrete eggs.



TASTING NOTE

Color: light raspberry-red.

Aroma: red fruits, such as raspberries and sour cherries, in addition to faint earthy and spicy notes that recall cinnamon.

Flavor: intensely fresh and fruity, of soft structure and medium body, the wine invites you to drink one glass after the other.

Food pairing: cured meats and cheeses, pasta with tomato sauce, lean meats and spicy dishes.

Serving temperature: 12 - 14° C.
